# STUBBINGTON 10K

## BEFORE THE RACE

Ensure you collect your race number with integrated timing chip and your race memento (sizes on a first come first served basis) from our race helpers in the Crofton Community Centre on Saturday 11th January from 09:30 - 15:00 or on the morning of the race between 08:00 - 09:30. Please note this is a change to previous years when we have used the Scout Hall

## ON THE DAY

- Limited Parking available in Crofton Secondary School; Crofton Anne Dale Junior School and Baycroft School (see Parking)
- Aim to arrive early to collect your race number with timing chip
- Baggage can be left in the main hall as last year.
- 09:30 – Titchfield Road closure and Number and Chip collection closed
- 09:35 - Runners will start moving to the race start from Stubbington Square by wave colour
- 10:00 - Race starts
- 12:00 ish - Prize giving; refreshments available at the Crofton Community Centre.

## LOCAL SUPPORT

## ROAD CLOSURES

A total of 8KM of road closures will be in place for competitor safety. 2KM of the route is open to traffic and marshals and signs en-route will advise runners to keep on the left hand side of the road to minimise the impact on all other road users.

**Please ensure you adhere to the marshals' requests to keep left.**

The final road closure at Stubbington Lane, will give you a traffic-free sprint to the finish line.

Road closures will be phased as follows:

- Stubbington Square, 08:30 - 13:00
- B3334 Titchfield Road, 09:30 - 10:30
- Bridge Street / Coach Hill, 09:45 - 10:40
- Posbrook Lane, 09:50 - 11:15
- Meon Road / Posbrook, 10:00 - 11:30
- Stubbington Lane, 09:30 - 11:30

## FUN RUN

Entry for the fun run will take place on the day. Places are limited to 100 and entry costs £1. Every participant will receive a medal and some goodies!

## RACE HEADQUARTERS

Crofton Community Centre on Stubbington Lane, PO14 2PP, will once again be our Race HQ. At the Race HQ you can pick up your number, your baggage labels, store your bag, enjoy tasty refreshments and access toilets and showers. Alton Sports will have a pop-up shop offering a great selection of apparel and running advice.

## NUMBER & CHIP COLLECTION

With 2000 competitors taking part this year, aim to collect your race number with timing chip on Saturday from the Crofton Community Centre. Expect large queues if you collect on the day.

Collection opening hours:

- Saturday 12th January 09:30 - 15:00
- Sunday 13th January 08:00 - 09:30

**Please note that you must not give anyone else your number! Anyone discovered running under another person's number will be disqualified from this and future races.**

## START LINE SQUEEZE

For safety reasons, competitors will need to meet in Stubbington Square in order to be escorted to the start line.

At 09:30 Titchfield Road will be closed, marshals will confirm that traffic has been stopped.

At 09:35 competitors will be directed to walk towards the start line based on their allocated wave colour – Yellow, White, Green and then Red

For your safety please locate your wave and remain there. Remember, your race time only starts from the moment you cross the start line.

## MID-POINT WATER STATION

We provide a water station with water in biodegradable cups at about half way. Please ensure that you throw your cup down within the water station area so that we don't have any litter elsewhere on the course. Anybody seen littering risks disqualification.

## PARKING

Parking is limited so, please consider car sharing where possible. If you are local why not jog to the start as a part of your warm up?

Parking is available free of charge from:

- Crofton Secondary School, Marks Road, Stubbington, PO14 2AT - 10 minute walk
- Baycroft School, Gosport Road, Stubbington, PO14 2AE - 10 minute walk
- Crofton Anne Dale Junior School, Cuckoo Lane, Stubbington, PO14 3PH – 1 minute walk.
- If you park in the streets of Stubbington please ensure that you are considerate to the residents and don't block exits – we need to ensure we continue to get the support of the local residents

UK Athletics Rules apply during this race. Normal headphones are not allowed during the race as you will need to hear marshal's instructions.

However in line with UKA rules bone conducting open ear devices will be allowed.
